DEAR COMMUNITY AND MEMBERS,

Happy 100th Anniversary to the Junior League of Denver! We had a wonderful year celebrating all the JLD has contributed to the Denver community.

Junior League members were generous with their time, talent and treasure and gave back in a big way. Provisionals, Actives and Sustainers collectively contributed 106,545 hours of volunteer service in various ways, including our Second Annual L.U.V.S. day of service, 166 DIAD projects and continued dedication to our community placements. We fulfilled the second year of a three-year commitment to giving \$100,000 back to the Denver community by granting \$50,000 to eight deserving organizations. Through various fundraising events and annual campaign efforts, we raised more than \$300,000 to help with the immediate needs of the JLD and raised \$170,000 for the JLD Foundation to ensure the JLD can continue its important work.

We grew our commitment to training passionate, committed civic leaders by conducting 112 organized training opportunities and 158 public policy calls to action. Additionally, we took on a rare Level One public policy engagement by backing Full-Day Kindergarten for all in Colorado with great success.

We connected at member events and celebrations throughout the year, beginning with a ribbon cutting ceremony at our recently renovated building in August 2018 and culminating with a Centennial Jubilee in May 2019 to celebrate and welcome our 157 Provisional members to Active status.

Thanks to the generosity of members and friends who have grown our JLD Foundation over many years, our JLDF was able to gift the JLD just over \$289,000 in 2018–2019 to support its Mission and programs. This gift allowed for the expansion of our annual L.U.V.S. day of service, contributed to our community granting commitments, helped underwrite the publication of our sixth cookbook and much more.

Due to increased fundraising success in recent years, careful fiscal stewardship, and the release of *Centennial Celebrations* in July, we are pleased to share that the JLD closed its 100th year in excellent financial health. As a result, the JLD requested a reduced gift from the JLDF in 2019–2020 so that a greater portion of funds can remain invested in the JLD Foundation for our future.

As we close this milestone year, we can all look back and be proud of how our organization started 100 years ago and where it's going for the next 100 years. We are inspired to march forward into our 101st year with the valued commitment of our leadership, members and community partners.

WHO WE ARE

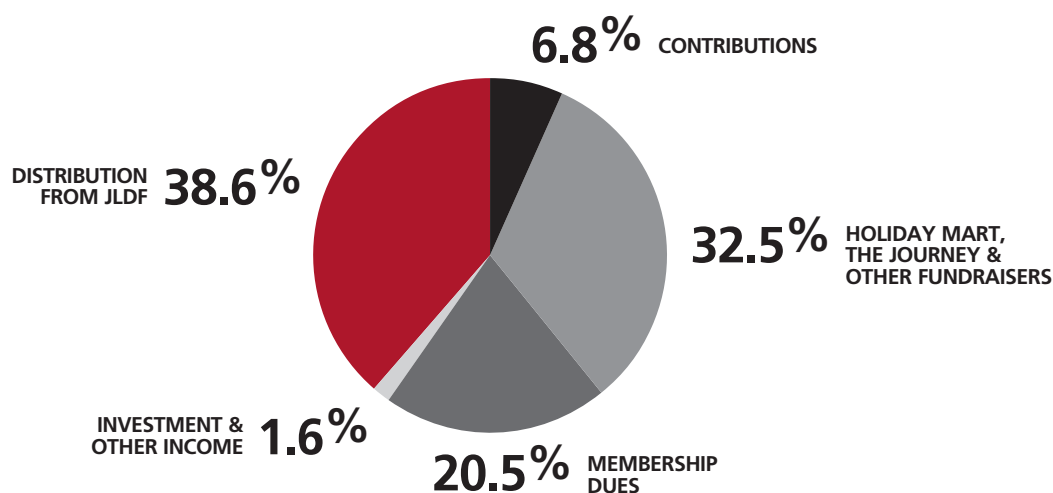

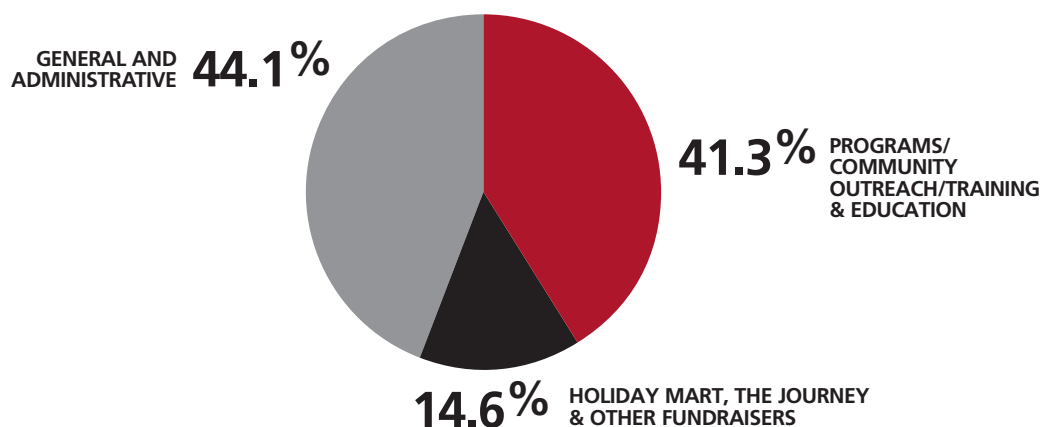

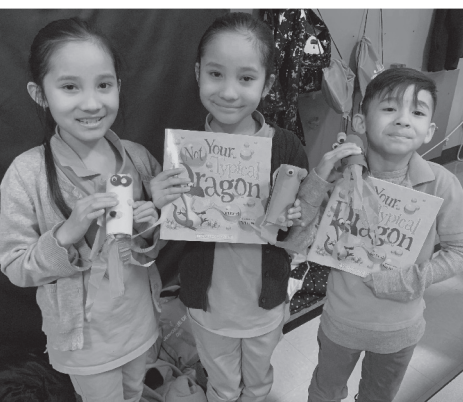


JLD FOUNDATION

In 1992, JLD Foundation founding members recognized a need to provide the means to sustain the JLD and its Mission long term. The Foundation now provides approximately 30% of the League's annual operating budget each year. On May 31, 2019, the portfolio balance was \$7,517,083. Thanks to the generosity of you, our members, and careful stewardship of the Foundation, the 2018–2019 distribution to JLD was \$289,653. The annual distribution is given in accordance with JLD Foundation policies to be expended as the JLD Board determines. The Foundation continues to create a culture of philanthropy where members give what they can in a way that honors their personal giving goals. Our JLD Foundation is a powerful tool, allowing us to increase our direct impact on the community. Thank you for your support and generosity.

GIFT OF TIME

Unpaid volunteers have donated a significant number of hours to assist the League in achieving the goals of its various service programs. In the 2018–2019 year, our members donated approximately 79,000 hours. We sincerely thank our members for their time and talents!

JLD L.U.V.S. — LEADERS UNITED IN VOLUNTEER SERVICE

JLD L.U.V.S. day of service celebrated “A Century of Progress” on Saturday, September 22. 215 JLD members came together in honor of our 100th Anniversary by serving 10 community partners we have worked with over the past century: Children’s Hospital Colorado, DPL Friends Foundation, Florence Crittenton Services, Girls Inc. of Metro Denver, CHARG Resource Center, Craig Hospital, SafeHouse Denver, The GrowHaus, Denver Botanic Gardens and The Gathering Place.

ONE BOOK COLORADO

On April 8, Governor Jared Polis and Denver Mayor Michael Hancock launched One Book Colorado 2019 at Denver Public Library. JLD provided a \$10,000 sponsorship for the seventh consecutive year. More than 75,000 copies of *Penguinaut!* by Marcie Colleen were distributed to every four-year-old in Colorado. Learn more at onebookcolorado.org.

2018–2019 COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

- **Done in a Day:** JLD provides volunteers to nonprofits for short-term projects throughout the Denver metro area. We completed 166 shifts, and members spent 2,808 hours on Done in a Days in the community. Additionally, we provided 4,676 meals and distributed 1,390 books through this program.
- **The Gathering Place:** JLD serves meals at Denver’s only daytime drop-in shelter for women, their children, and transgender individuals experiencing poverty or homelessness. We completed 27 volunteer shifts, donated 437 volunteer hours, served 1,640 meals and provided the shelter’s milk supply for the year.
- **Grants:** JLD granted \$50,000 to eight nonprofit organizations in 2018–2019: The Growhaus (\$17,000); Hope House of Colorado (\$5,000); Scholars Unlimited (\$5,000); Denver Santa Claus Shop (\$3,000); DPL Friends Foundation (\$3,000); Second Chance Center (\$10,000); Write Our World (\$5,000) and Anchor Center for Blind Children (\$2,000).
- **Kids Connect:** JLD designed and implemented this literacy-based program centered on early childhood brain development, currently held at Sewall Child Development Center on the Dahlia Campus for Health. More than 149 children and their caregivers attended 12 program nights with more than 237 books distributed and 271 meals served.
- **Read2Kids:** JLD designed and implemented this event-based program promoting literacy through access to books and parental/caregiver involvement. We served 13 partner schools, donated 885 volunteer hours, served 1,878 meals and distributed 3,805 new books to 1,208 kids and their families. Our partner profile targets Denver metro area schools with 85%+ of students qualifying for free or discounted lunch. A special thank you to Buckingham Strategic Wealth for granting \$5,000 to Read2Kids this year.
- **Tutoring with Kids:** JLD provided two types of one-on-one tutoring.
 - Reading Partners Colorado:* Volunteers donated 82 hours of face-to-face tutoring to help children master reading fundamentals for their grade level. We distributed 263 books to the participants.
 - TutorMate:* Volunteers donated approximately 60 hours to this online literacy program that helps prevent kids from falling behind their suggested reading level. We distributed 100 books to the participants.

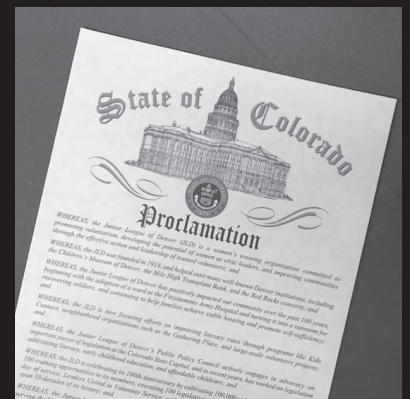

- **Philanthropic Development (formerly Talent Management):** Provides training to help women develop their civic and philanthropic skills.
- **Personal Development (formerly University League):** Identifies personal enrichment opportunities.
- **Get on Board:** Completed an extremely successful pilot year in 2018-2019. Focused on training our members to be effective, productive, and valuable assets to other nonprofit boards in our community.
